Introduction:

Agricultural Value Chain Mapping encompasses identifying stakeholders, key processes, and bottlenecks at all stages of bringing a product from production to market, to enhance overall efficiency and productivity. Climate Change poses significant risks to agri-value chains and underscores urgent need integrate climate resilience to into value chain interventions to achieve poverty reduction and food security goals. Climate Resilient Agriculture involves implementing sustainable farming practices such as conservation, and crop water management, soil diversification to climate change. To build value chains that are climate resilient, each actor along the value chain must assess climate risks and manage the activities that make up the value chain adaptivity.

Fee & Mode of Payment: The programme is sponsored by NABARD and hence **no participation fee** is collected from banks towards boarding, lodging and to impart training to the participants. However, concerned Bank may bear the to and fro travelling cost of the participants to attend the programme.
