The programme is slated during 20-26th November 2023.

As you are aware, Philippines is acclaimed for its successful initiatives and developments in the sphere of Agri Value Chain Financing.

Brief details of the programme are indicated in the enclosed brochure.

We request you to kindly consider nominating suitable officers from your Organisation/Department for the programme. There are a maximum of 25 seats for the programme on 'first come first served' basis. Being an international visit programme, a lot of logistics have to be tied up well before the commencement of the programme.

The programme fee per participant, which includes all costs, boarding, lodging, training and site visits in Philippines, will be Rs.2,24,200/- (including GST and excluding travel). Participants have to reach Manila, Philippines on 20 Nov 2023, ideally between 3:00 – 5:00 PM Manila time. Suitable early bird discount would be available for receipt of nomination by 10 October 2023. The institutions offering 4 or more nominations would also get suitable institutional discount upto 20 October 2023.

The last date for nomination/substitution/ cancellation requests is 20 October 2023.

The nominees MUST have a valid passport (atleast 6 months from time of travel) at the time of nomination/commencement of travel to avoid delay in the processing of their visa. Application and renewal of passport also take time and it will substantially affect the processing of the visa. We will appreciate if you can submit nominations together with their registration forms latest by 15 October 2023.
